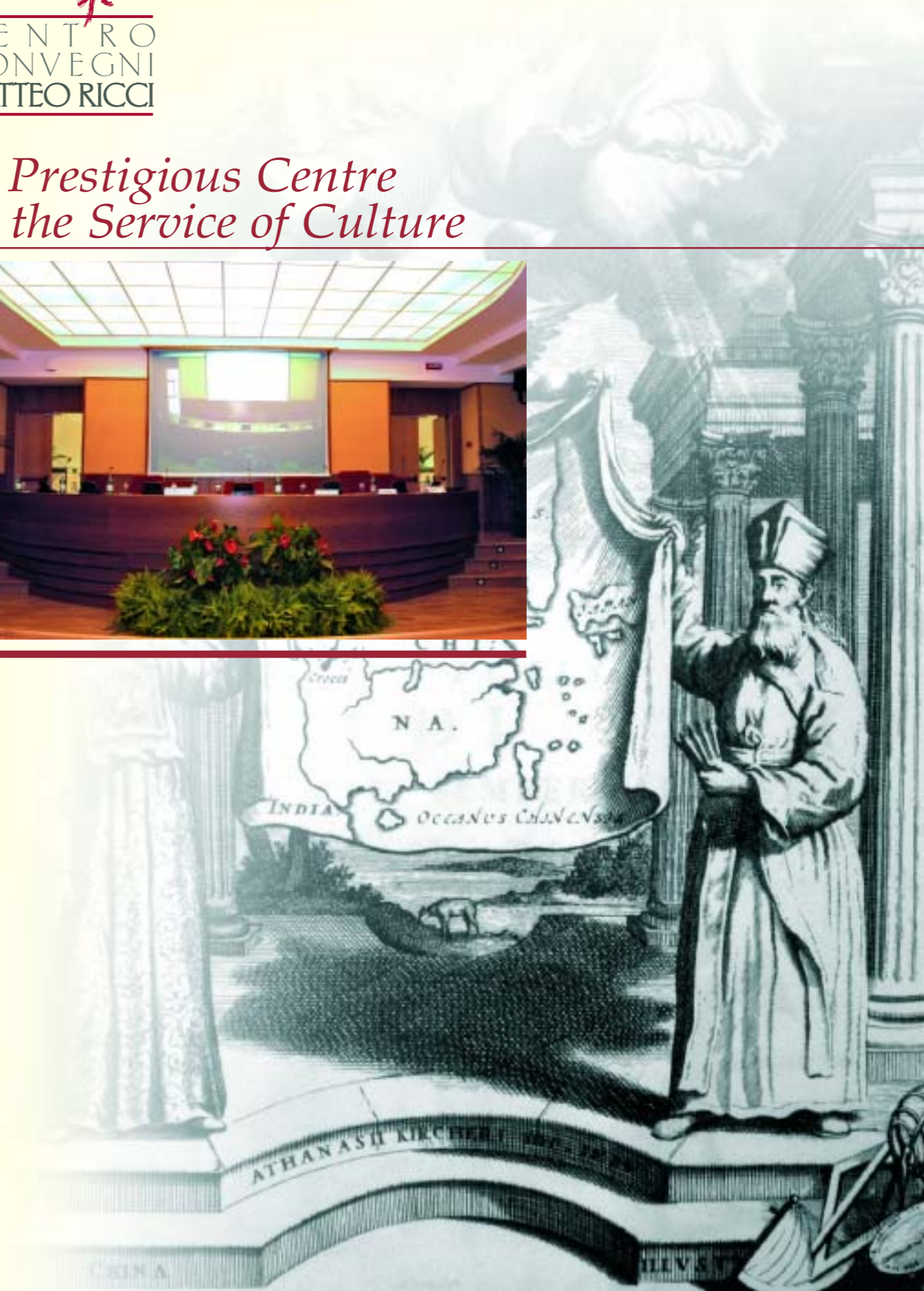


**How to get there**

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## A Prestigious Centre at the Service of Culture

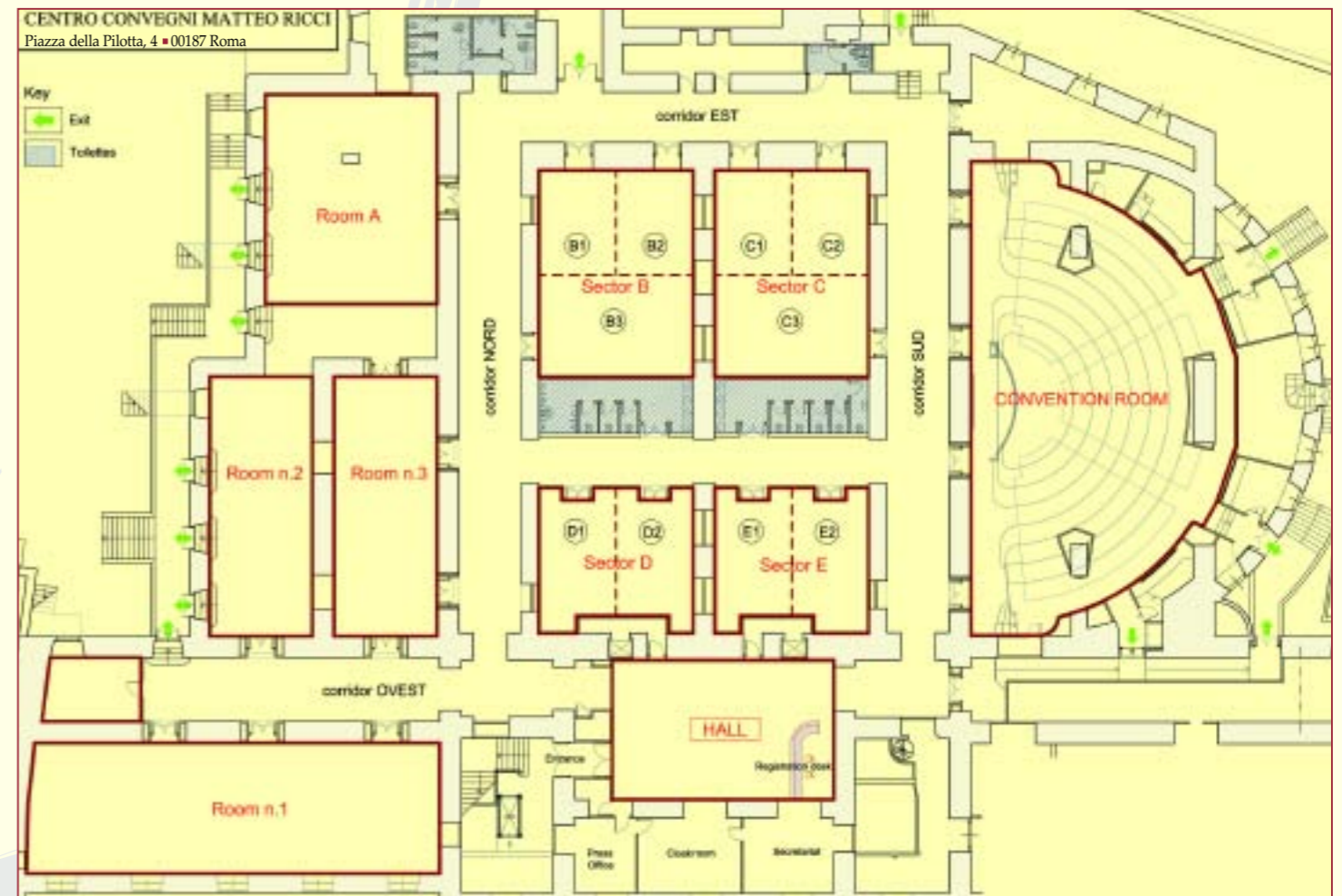


The Centre offers an amphitheatre-style meeting space with a seating capacity of 226, three booths for simultaneous translation and an audio/video control booth; a room for 100 persons; a large exhibition area; and a variety of multi-purpose rooms. These versatile rooms may be adapted to create separate break-out spaces by adding or removing soundproof dividing walls.

The whole Convention Centre is provided with structured wiring with high-speed voice/data/video cabling and all the rooms can be connected by a closed circuit audio/video system. In several common areas, wireless networking is also available.

In addition to the meeting facilities, there are support facilities for catering services, a spacious foyer with a cloakroom to welcome the participants to the conferences, a VIP lounge and two offices for the event organizers and the press. Two spacious rooms, one leading to an exterior garden, are ideal for coffee breaks, buffet lunches, exhibitions and other functions.

The Convention Centre, designed to provide the latest in efficiency and multi-functionality, aims to be a quality space for cultural dialogue, unique for its size and convenience in the centre of Rome.



- Registration area: main hall reception desk and cloakroom.
- Offices: secretary, press (a bigger press office can be organized in any other room).
- Main conference room.
- Room for 100 seats (A).
- 4 rooms for 20 (E1, E2, D1, D2).
- 4 rooms for 15 (C1, C2, B1, B2).
- 2 rooms for 32 (C3, B3).
- 1 big multifunctional room (1).
- 2 reception rooms (2 & 3).
- Corridors for poster sessions (3 m/9 ft. wide, N, S, E, W).

Also, by removing the walls:

- 2 rooms for 40 (E1+E2, D1+D2).
- 2 rooms for 30 (C1+C2, B1+B2).
- 2 rooms for 100 (C1+C2+C3, B1+B2+B3).

and kitchen for caterers, services, storerooms for furnishing, supplies, etc.
